Our College...

Ours is an autonomous institution, run by the members of the Society of Jesus, commonly called as JESUITS. The college was founded in 1950 as a Christian minority institution. The admission is made open to all without the distinction of caste or religion. Our preference in admission is for the poor, especially from rural areas and for those who opt to work in rural areas for the benefit of the poor. The Moto of our College is '**Veritate Lumen et Vita**' which means '*Life and Light through Truth*'. Further the vision of our college *aims at the integral formation of prospective teachers and the promotion of educational research at the service of our youth for the establishment of a just and humane society.*

The college is affiliated to Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, Chennai from 2008-2009. UGC has conferred on our college, the autonomous status, from 2006-07. Our college was re-accredited (4th Cycle) with 'A+' Grade by NAAC with CGPA: 3.29 for a period of Five years from 2021-22. The college offers B.Ed., M.Ed. and Ph.D. (Full Time and Part-Time) programmes in Education.

B.ED. PROGRAMME (2 YEARS)

Eligibility

The Candidate (Boy/Girl) who has obtained a UG degree under 10+2+3 pattern in the recognized secondary schools and Colleges in Tamil nadu or a Post-Graduate Degree in the same subject taken at UG level of the Universities in Tamil Nadu or a Degree of some other University accepted by the Syndicate of the Universities in Tamil nadu as Equivalent there to with the Subject Concerned as the Major in Part III of their Bachelor Degree Examination, with a Minimum of 50% marks in Part III (Major and Allied Subjects) for OC, 45% for BC, 43% for MBC, and 40% Marks for SC/ST.

Duration and Norms

The course of study shall be for four semesters. The total number of working days of a year will be 200 (Two hundred) inclusive of Intensive Practice Teaching, School/Community based activities and exclusive of Admission and Examination work. The course work will be 2550 hours. A total of 90% attendance is expected of a student to appear for the semester exams.

Courses of Study

The programme will have core courses, any two-school subject oriented pedagogy courses, elective courses, experience for teacher enrichment, experience for social and environmental sensitivity, self-study courses and other practical activities such as Practice teaching in a recognized School, Community survey and preparation of report, Action research/Field work/Case study, Participation in community games and festivals, Organization of games and sports, Organization of supplementary educational activities, Sessional work in pedagogical courses and their evaluation, Addressing assemblies and debates, Physical education and work experience, Tests to evaluate performance and all abilities, Preparation of Teaching Learning Materials (TLM), Socially Useful Productive Work (SUPW), Maintenance of educational records, Club activities and community service camp, Evaluation of text books and reading materials, Literary activities and Organisation of tours and Filed trips.

Add-on Diploma Programme and Value-Added

Our college offers an add-on diploma programme in Digital Pedagogy to all the B.Ed. students along with a completion certificate by the college, which will enable them to integrate ICT in their future career. Additionally, our college offers value-added courses based on their choice under different specific domains such as Aari work, Home Decoration, Photography and Basic Computer Literacy.

Hostel Facility

Hostel facility is available for Boys and Girls separately, providing both vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals. It is run on the basis of dividing system. Hostel admission is done separately by the Directors of Bellarmine House for Boys and Britto Hostel for Girls.

M.Ed. PROGRAMME (2 YEARS)

Eligibility

The Men and Women who have passed a Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) of the Universities of Tamilnadu or Any other Universities accepted by the syndicate of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, are admitted in the M.Ed. programme. The minimum marks required for M.Ed. admission is 50% of marks in B.Ed. programme theory and practical separately.

Duration

The Course of study shall be for a duration of four semesters. Total number of working days shall be 200 for an academic year. The Course work will be 2400 hours.

Programme Content

The programme has perspective courses, tool courses, specialization, internship, and Project with Viva-voce examination.
