

On 5th Sep 2019, road safety awareness was given to the students in the assembly. Noto's & Manager of Aathi Maruthi explained the traffic rules and signals.

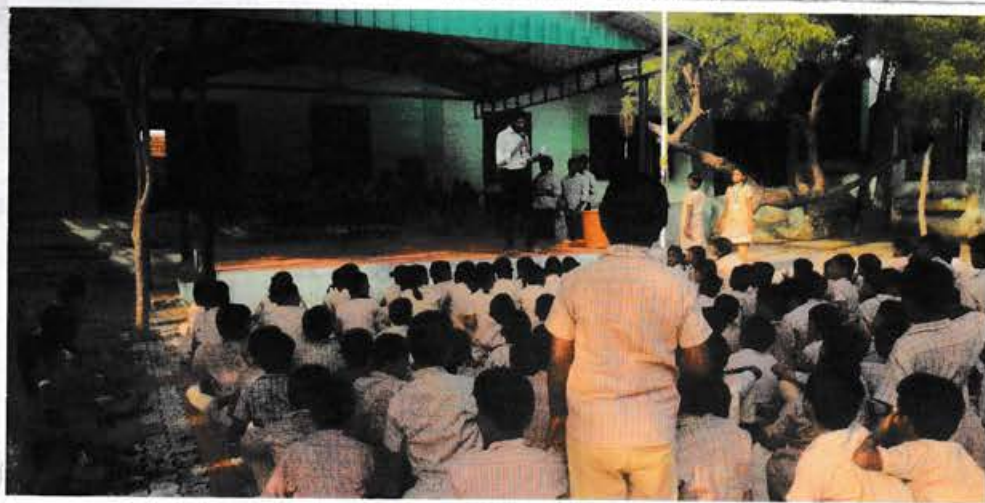
They gained more information about the traffic rules and they were also talked about the importance of teacher in the contemporary society.
