

STUDENTS' SATISFACTION SURVEY DETAILS

The students are satisfied with the college activities in the year 2018-19. In the evaluation of I Semester activities, more than 80% of students are satisfied with the suitability of courses offered, microteaching practice, lesson plan writing, demo teaching, peer teaching, preliminary teaching practice, availability of books in library and organization of awareness programmes.

Orientation programme, uploading of syllabus, preparation of lessons by teacher educators, discussions in the classroom, daily assembly, quiz competition, self improvement in teaching skills, development of communication and ethical issues in teaching profession were highly appreciated by more than 70% of students. All other items were satisfied by more than 60% of students except the time for internal examination in which only 45.95% were satisfied.

In the second semester, more than 90% of students are satisfied with the special schools visit, topics and deadline for submission of assignments, celebration of festivals, intramural competitions, educational tour, development of ability, communication skill, understanding the basic values involved in teaching profession.

The programmes like suitability of courses, community camp, teacher educators preparation and discussion in the classroom, continuous internal assessment, awareness programme, morning assembly, the scheme 'one rupee a day', development of English language were agreed to be good by more than 80% of students.

The tuition in Joy Bhavan and Video conferencing were accepted as a good programme by only 42.6% of students.
