### **1<sup>st</sup> August 2016**

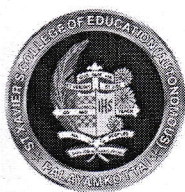

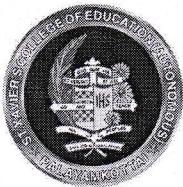
**01 & 02 August 2017**
