- g. The concept English Laboratory may be included in Special English Education also.
- h. The practicum on 'report writing' may be included in General English Education.
- i. Macaulay Minutes may be included in the paper 'Vision of Education in India'.
- In the paper 'Gender Issues in Education', Varma Committee Report may be included.
- In the paper 'Gender Issues in Education', Teachers Role should be emphasized.
- Orientation on 'How to face interview' may be organized.
- m. Micro-teaching needs follow up.
