# **Syllabus Completion**

It is inferred from the feedback that 100% of students agreed that the professor had completed 85 to 100% of the syllabus in the class and covered the syllabus in the normal speed (88%) and 90.9% agreed that he completed the syllabus a week ahead.

#### **Preparation for Class**

Regarding preparation, 100% of the students appreciated his preparation and 100% revealed that there was an effective power point presentation and all of them agreed that the video displayed in the class was relevant.

## Communication

Regarding the communication, 94% of students agreed that his communication was always effective and 70% students appreciated him for effective voice modulation and 94% appreciated for the usage of simple and appropriate vocabulary in the class 100% of them appreciated him for moderate pace of speaking.

## **Classroom Management**

Regarding the classroom management, 81% of them appreciated the professor for the maintenance of discipline in the classroom. 63% of students observed that he made all the

students' attentive in the class and 81% of them felt happy as he established an excellent rapport with the students.

#### **Academic Mentoring**

Regarding to this dimension, 63% strongly agreed that the teacher educator identified the strengths and encouraged the students by providing right level of challenges and 63% of them strongly agreed that he helped them in writing assignment. All the students appreciated that the teacher educator clarified the doubts of the students in a nice manner and 81% of them observed that teacher educator was always available for academic consultation and 50% of them agreed that he took remedial teaching always. 88% of them agreed that the task was allotted in the library hour was useful and 81% of them assured that he monitored the students in the library hour.

## **Evaluation**

With regard to internal evaluation, 100% of them agreed that fairness was maintained by him and 69% of them agreed that the performance of the students in the assignments was discussed every time by the teacher educator

## **Teaching Methodology**

Regarding this dimension, 75% of students observed that he illustrated the concepts through examples and applications and 62.5% of them appreciated the teacher educator for using student-centric methods, such as discussion, participative learning and problem solving for enhancing learning experiences

Regarding the use of ICT tools, 93.8% of students revealed that he always used ppt, related videos in the class and 81% of them observed that he was excellent in linking with today's situation. 94% of them appreciated that he summed up the lesson regularly and 54.5% of them revealed that he limitedly used the blackboard.

#### **Teacher Behaviour in the classroom**

With regard to teacher behaviour, 63.6% of them appreciated that the teacher behaviour in the classroom was very good. All of them revealed that he was always impartial. All of them felt he had a friendly approach towards the students and all of them felt his words in the conversation were respectful.

#### **Personal Mentoring**

Regarding the personal mentoring, 55% of them felt that he identified the weaknesses of the students and helped them to overcome the same all the time and 40% of them felt

happy that he had personal contact with the students and 63% of students agreed that he sometimes listened to the personal problems of the students.

#### Dr. R. Sathesh Franklin – Disaster Management

96.2% of them responded that 85–100% of the syllabus was covered in the class. 76.9% of them responded that the pace of syllabus completion was normal, 15.4% felt it was hurried, and 7.7% felt it was slow. 84.6% of them responded that the syllabus was completed a week ahead, while 15.4% stated it was completed two days before the internal test. No one reported last-minute completion or incomplete syllabus.

88.5% of them rated the teacher educator's preparation as very good, while 11.5% rated it as good. None rated it as poor. 96.2% of them stated that the PowerPoint presentations were effective. There were no responses for not effective or no PowerPoint presentation. 96.2% of them responded that the videos displayed were relevant. There were no responses indicating irrelevance or ineffectiveness.

88.5% of them responded that the communication was always effective, while 11.5% felt it was sometimes effective. None rated it as generally ineffective. 92.3% of them responded that the voice modulation was effective, and 7.7% suggested it needed improvement. None reported no voice modulation. 96.2% of them reported that the vocabulary used was simple and appropriate. None felt it was difficult, vague, or contained too many words.

73.1% of them rated the maintenance of discipline as very good, while 26.9% rated it as good. None rated it as poor. 65.4% of them responded that most students were attentive, while 34.6% felt all students were attentive. None stated that only a few students were attentive. 80.8% of them rated the rapport as good, while 19.2% rated it as excellent. None rated it as poor.

100% of them responded that the clarification of doubts was good, with no one rating it as poor or stating that the teacher discouraged questions. m84.6% of them responded that the teacher educator was occasionally available, while 15.4% stated they were always available. None reported unavailability.

69.2% of them responded that no remedial teaching was undertaken, 19.2% said it was occasional, and 11.5% said it was always provided.96.2% of them responded that ICT tools were always used, with no one stating occasional or no usage. 84.6% of them responded that the theme of the lesson was summed up occasionally, while 15.4% stated it was summed up regularly. None indicated that it was not summed up. 84.6% of them rated the behavior as very good, while 15.4% rated it as good. None rated it as poor.

#### Elective: Gender Issues in Education - Dr. M. Antony Raj

87.5% of the respondents indicated that 85–100% of the syllabus was covered, while 12.5% indicated 70–84% coverage. 75% found the pace of syllabus completion normal, whereas 25% felt it was hurried. 68.8% stated the syllabus was completed a week ahead, and 21.9% noted completion two days before the internal test.

75% rated the teacher's preparation as very good, and 25% as good. 100% of respondents found PowerPoint presentations and displayed videos effective and relevant. 93.8% felt communication was always effective. 96.9% rated voice modulation as effective, with 3.1% suggesting improvement.

Vocabulary was unanimously rated as simple and appropriate. 71.9% rated discipline maintenance as very good, while 28.1% rated it as good. 75% felt most students were attentive, and 25% stated all were attentive. Rapport was rated as excellent by 28.1% and good by 71.9%.

96.9% felt doubt clarification was good. 84.4% said the teacher was occasionally available for academic consultation, and 15.6% said they were always available. 62.5% mentioned no remedial teaching, while 28.1% noted occasional sessions. 93.8% indicated consistent use of ICT tools.

90.6% reported that lesson themes were occasionally summed up. Behavior was rated very good by 25% and good by 75%. 100% agreed on fairness in internal evaluations.

#### **Elective - Teacher Educator: Dr. A. Nicholas Jegan**

93.1% of the respondents indicated that 85–100% of the syllabus was covered, while 6.9% indicated 70–84% coverage. 75.9% found the pace of syllabus completion normal, 13.8% felt it was slow, and 10.3% felt it was hurried. 72.4% stated the syllabus was completed a week ahead, while 24.1% noted completion two days before the internal test.

62.1% rated the teacher's preparation as very good, and 31% as good. 89.7% found PowerPoint presentations effective, while 10.3% felt they were not effective. 96.6% reported that videos were relevant to the topic.


